# **Role of fieldwork in geomorphology**

March 11-13, 2015 Pilsen, CZ

The forthcoming 15<sup>th</sup> annual ČAG conference will be held in the city of Pilsen, Czech Republic. Pilsen, being built on the confluence of four rivers and their terraces, is inspiring place for scientific discussions. The conference topic will be the role of fieldwork in the geomorphology of various environments and other progressive issues that move geomorphology towards new horizons. Packed with ancient history, being the European Capital of Culture for the year 2015 and the World Capital of Beer indefinitely, the city of Pilsen offers a wealth of attractions and activities that are hard to find elsewhere in the Czech Republic or Central Europe. The conference will be held in the ceremonial halls of the famous Pilsner Urquell Brewery. The financial aid of the NEXLIZ project allowed us to invite some European best known experts to head sections and provide invited speeches. So far we have positive confirmation from Prof Minár (Comenius University, Bratislava), Dr Evans (University of Durham), Dr Hutchinson (University of Salford), Dr Diedrich (Paleo-logic) and Dr Mindrescu (University of Suceava).

- *Water, water, every where!* – Fluvial geomorphosystems on the roof of Europe.
- *We need to go deeper!* – Tectonic and structural geomorphology.
- *Yes, how many years can a mountain exist, before it is washed to the sea?* – Slope processes and slope-channel coupling.
- *Quo vadis?* – Section opened for the geomorphology students and graduates.

- March 11-13, 2015: Conference.

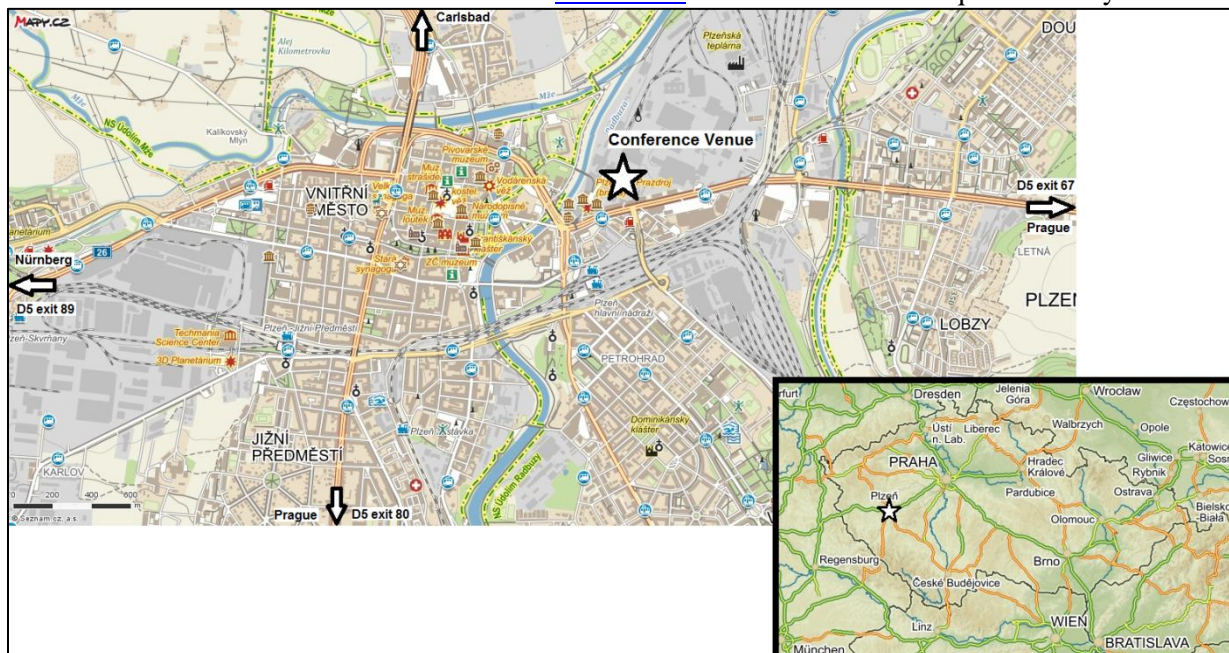
